Learning Objective:

- 4. Who is in the portrait that Elwood places on the mantle?
- 5. Who is going to go to Charlie's Place to question Elwood?
- 6. Who is packing their belongings from Chumley's Rest?
- 7. Who comes to the sanitarium to pick up Dr. Sanderson and Nurse Kelly?
- 8. Who threatens harm to Elwood while he is stating the facts of the evening?
- 9. Who runs into the Reception Room while being pursued by Harvey?
