## Let's Get Started / Warm Up Activities:

Go sit in your bedroom. Describe the space with specific details. What impression, feeling, or story do you think your bedroom tells?





### Lesson Steps: Stage/Space/Sets



Now that you have studied the elements of design, you will put that knowledge to practice.

Today, you will draw a front view rendering of a design.

A rendering is the front view of what the audience would see. It should...

- Be in color
- Be detailed
- Include set dressing (if it is a room...rugs, pictures, etc.)



### Practice: Rendering, Dream Bedroom



At the beginning of this lesson, you were asked to describe your current bedroom in detail. Now, you are going to design a set for what you would call: THE DREAM BEDROOM!

- 1. First, describe your dream bedroom. How big would it be? Colors? Furniture? Decor? Windows? Closets?
- What feeling would you want those that enter the room to experience? How can you emphasize this feeling through design elements? Line? Color? Texture? Etc.
- Now, that you have brainstormed draw out a front view rendering of your set design for THE DREAM <u>BEDROOM!</u>
