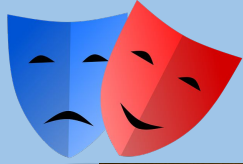

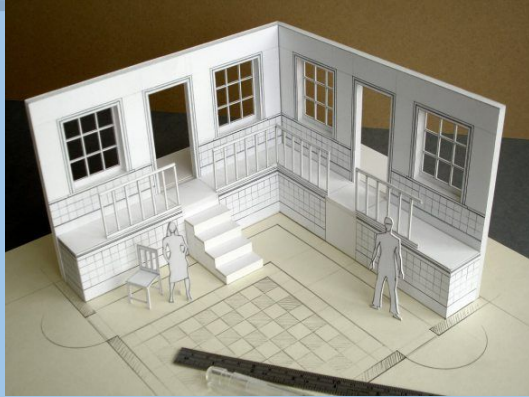
Let's Get Started / Warm Up Activities:

Lesson Steps: 3D Model Challenge



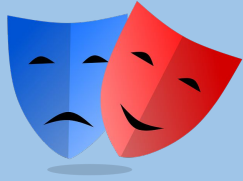
When designing a space, set designers use set models to share their design interpretations.
