
Objective/Learning Target: Students will research current working actors and study their methods of acting.




Oh to be Inspired: Actor Biographies

Let's Get Started / Warm Up Activities:

Using the actor you researched yesterday, what production/work of theirs is your favorite? Why?



Lesson: Oh to be Inspired! Actor Biographies



Yesterday, you spent time learning about the background and career of an award-winning actor.

Today, you will watch part of their work and analyze their acting choices.

First, choose one of the following:

-A scene from a performance they for which they received a nomination or award.

-A scene from your favorite work of theirs.

Practice: Oh to be Inspired! Actor Biographies

Now that you have chosen the scene you would like to explore today, reflect on the following questions:

- 1. First watch the scene again just to enjoy it!
- 2. Second, watch the scene without sound and take note of their physical/nonverbal choices. How do these choices develop the character? How do these choices help make the performance believable?
- 3. Third, watch the scene with sound and take not of their vocal choices. How do these choices develop the character? How do these choices help make the performance believable?
- 4. Finally, using your research from yesterday on the actor's "method", do you believe it was helpful in portraying a realistic character?
