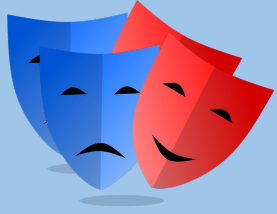
The student will explore the role of music and mood in theatrical sound design.

**Let's Get Started / Warm Up
Activities:**

3. For each moment that you choose do the following:
 - a. Brainstorm and research a song that you think would help establish the mood for this moment if it were staged
 - b. Write an explanation of why you choose the song to fit the moment.
 - c. At least ONE SONG must be instrumental.
