Lesson/Activity: Songs of Myself



Practice, Option One

- Brainstorm a list of different feelings that you or others might be feeling during this time of self-quarantine.
- 2. Brainstorm a list of events you or others might be experiencing during this time of self-quarantine.
- Choose 3 feelings and two events from your list.
- For each that you choose do the following:
 - a. Brainstorm and research a song that you think would help establish the mood for this moment
 - b. Write an explanation of why you choose the song to fit the moment.
 - At least ONE SONG must be instrumental.





Practice, Option Two



You have decided to write original music for the story.

- Choose a song that you can parody.
- Rewrite the lyrics to fit the current time and state of being that we are experiencing.
