Bell Ringer/Let's Get Started: What tools and skills have you learned that have allowed you to become a better researcher?

Lesson/Activity:

- List good ways an incoming drama student can find quality literature and pieces for performance.
 - Example: choosing a topic or story that you can personally connect to --it will get you through the whole year and allow you to process your own stories
- List **bad** ways an incoming drama student would find literature.
 - Example: choosing a book that you think everyone will like and will do well --it will bore you quickly when you can't connect; and when you can't connect, your audience can't connect

- Write a letter to incoming members of your team, specifically to the members who are
 going to be performing in the same category you will be performing in. Tell them the top
