Character	Master Gesture	Chest	Hips	Legs	Head/focal points	Accent/Dialect/Vocal Quality
THE NERD	Holding backpack, pushing up glasses	Sunken, shoulders very forward	Pushed forward to emphasize chest (lack of confidence)	Squatty, apart	Upwards focal point, probably darts around the room because too nervous to make eye contact	Nasally, snorts at times
