Lesson: Building a Scale Model of a Flat

Today, you will use your scale drawing of a flat to build a scale model.

A scale model is most generally a physical representation of an object that maintains accurate relationships between all important aspects of the model.





Practice

- 1. Today you will use $\frac{1}{2}$ " = 1' scale to build a model of a flat.
- 2. First, gather supplies. Below are suggestions, but you can get creative with that you have!
- 3. Building Material Options:
 - a. Paper, Notecards, Glue, Tape, Scissors
 - b. Legos, paper, and tape
 - c. Cardboard Box, Glue, Tape, Scissors
 - d. Popsicle Sticks, Glue, Tape, Scissors
- 4. Build a scale model of a flat. Then, label each of the parts of the flat.
