Options for marking your text:

/-Pause

//-Pause and change of thought/beat

///-Major Pause and shift in the play or scene

<-Get louder

>-Get softer

~-Get faster

...-Get slower

Circle an operative word per word group.

An operative word is the one word that we must hear in a sentence in order for that sentence and the next to make sense

Units of Action or beats (events)

A major change of thought, action or situation. By doing this you are able to commit moment by moment rather than attempting to act the entire selection at one time
