#### **Practice**

Apply Stanislavski's Method to a character from a piece or your program you recently made:

- 1. Objectives: the character want, need, or goal

- 3. **Tactics**: what strategies does your character use to get what he or she wants
- 4. Stakes: what does your character have to gain or lose through their objective
