What is a Blog?

Blogging enables you to reach the billions of people that use the Internet. Blogging can help you promote yourself or your business. Blogging works as a method for attracting an audience because it provides something of value to them before asking for anything in return

In the most common sense, it is a website that contains online personal reflections.

Blogs

- BLOGS allow us to go into deeper detail and to create a more immersive experience for the audience
- Enhances and encourages audience engagement
- Gives the writer an extended platform
- Allows for the information that couldn't be put into a story
- Encourages shared content
