Sub lesson for Monday, April 20: CANVA (part 1 of 2)

Objective/Learning Target:

Students will be able to use a Canva template to create social media posts.



Background Information

Facebook users are sharing 684,478 pieces of content per minute. Each day, there are more than 500 million Tweets processed on Twitter and 80 million photos posted to Instagram. With such an influx of content on social media, it's more difficult than ever for brands to stand out and get noticed.

Warm Up/Bellringer

The answer to these questions is to use images on social media.

"Don't believe that graphics have a tremendous effect on the posts that your share to social media? According to Twitter, tweets with photos receive an average 35% boost in Retweets. Social Media Strategist Jeff Bullas reports that Facebook posts with photos receive an average 37% increase in engagement."
