

Example

The superhero I created is called Captain Magnificent. His real name is Lucas Graham. He was an archaeologist from Detroit who studied Greek mythology. One day, he broke a clay pot and was exposed to a gas that turned him into Captain Magnificent. His powers include the ability to fly, super strength, and produce lightning bolts (like the Greek god Zeus). His headquarters is located at the top of Mount Olympus. The costume is black, blue and yellow and he wears a mask around his eyes. His arch-nemesis is Hades, a man exposed to a similar gas that gave him the ability to teleport and produce fire.
