Part V:

Important Vocabulary (copy!)

- **Invasive species**: a plant OR animal that moves in to an area where it does not belong (usually by accident)
- **Invader**: someone or something that invades a country, region, or other place
- **Swamp**: an area of low-lying, uncultivated ground where water collects
- **Larvae**: the active immature form of an insect, especially one that differs greatly from the adult and forms the stage between egg and pupa
- **Exotic**: originating in or characteristic of a distant country
- **Dangerous**: able or likely to cause harm or injury
