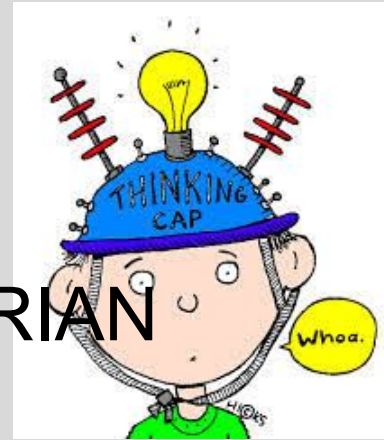
# How to Clarify Ideas
