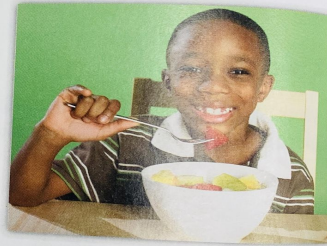

# Practice of “a” and “an”

## La Practica de “a” y “an”

“a” and “an” are called articulo gramaticalmente.

1. Do not use with plural nouns.

No usa con sustantivos plurales.

2. Use “a” with unspecific reference and before a consonant.

Usa “a” con referencias no específicas y antes un consonante.

3. Use “an” with unspecific reference and before vowels (a,e,i, o, u)

Usa “a” con referencias no específicas y antes vocales (a,e,i,o, u)

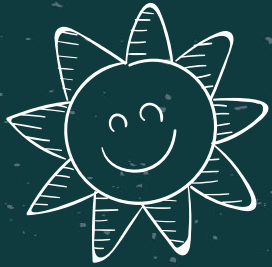
