
- Images of at least 5 different houses on your block (one must be yours)

Prairie Style Architecture

Elements and Principles:

- Color is used create emphasize and contrast the wood details around the windows
- Rhythm and Patterns are created by the rectangular shapes of the windows and wood trim
- ☐ The Scale of the columns provide a balance to the asymmetrical design of the house.



Characteristics:

- Hip roofs with extra wide eaves
- Long horizontal lines
- Natural building materials and finishes
- Deep front porch
- → Banks of windows
