Activity & Directions: Create a floor plan suitable for Early Childhood. See the format to use on the next slides to describe your plan for this activity/lesson.



Directions: In this assignment, you will be designing your ideal classroom. Things to think about are: technology you would want, the flow of the room, where supplies would go, etc.

Things that are required: teacher's desk, teacher resource/supply area, parent information area, bookcase(s), window(s), at least one door to the room, at least one bulletin board in the room, whiteboard/smart board, at least 6 center areas (Art, Science, Literacy/Reading & Writing, Sensory {Water, sand, etc table), Manipulative toys/puzzles, Building Area {blocks, legos, stackables}, Dramatic Play {props}, Living Environment {pets & plants}.



- You need to draw or construct your ideal classroom. You may use paper, poster, a website or a shoebox. If drawing, make sure to make the drawing is as <u>neat</u> as possible. **Label** all of the items that you place in your room.
