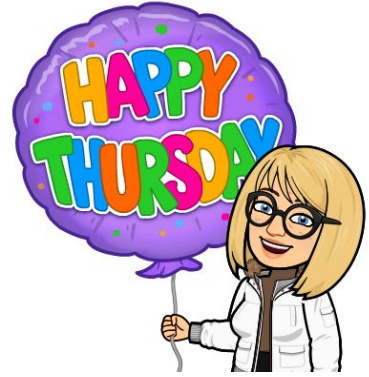

How to Say or Write the Date

To write or say the date in French, start with “le.” Then, you need the number for the day of the month. The month comes last. Remember not to capitalize the month.

Examples

le cinq décembre

le onze mars

le trois avril

How to Say or Write the Date

To say/write the date in French, use the cardinal numbers, i.e. 2 or 3, etc., instead of the ordinal numbers, i.e. 2nd or 3rd, etc. The only exception is the first day of each month.

Examples:

le six mars

le premier avril
(premier = first)

Examples

le quinze juillet

le dix mars

Dates in Numerical Form

In French, to write the date in numerical form, the day follows the month.

Examples

English

March 6th => 3/6

January 28th => 1/28

French

le 6 mars=> 6/3

le 28 janvier => 28/1

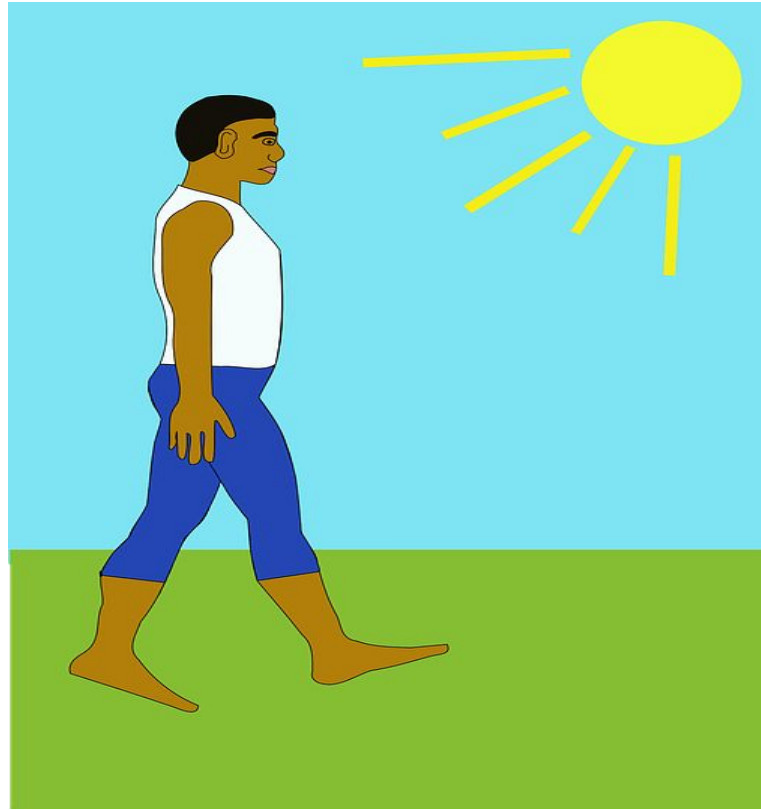
