24 Hour Clock

In France, it is very common to use the 24 hour clock. It is used frequently in conversation, but it is most commonly used in government, business and other official settings. For example, train schedules and doctor's office hours would be given using the 24 hour clock.

Why do you think the 24 hour clock might be preferable in these situations?

24 Hour Clock

The 24 hour clock is the same for hours from 1 a.m. to noon. For hours in the p.m., you add 12 to the hour.

Consequently, 1 p.m. becomes 13.00, and 11 p.m. becomes 23.00. The day ends at 23.59.

Midnight is 0.00, and so 12:15 a.m. is 0.15, etc.

Notice that the French use a period (.) instead of a colon (:) for the 24 hour clock. You also might see an “h” instead of the colon. For example, 19h00 = 7:00 p.m.


Practice
