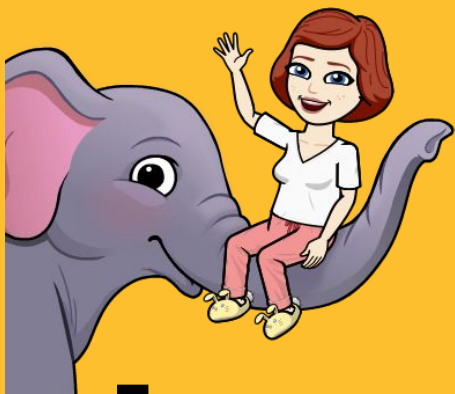

Le futur proche



I mentioned briefly yesterday that in order to form the futur proche, you conjugate the verb aller in the present tense and add the infinitive of the verb you are going to be doing.

For example:

Je **vais** **manger** des frites. - I'm going to eat some fries.

Vais is the present tense form of aller with je.

Manger is the infinitive that means "to eat".

Watch the video and take notes. There are excellent examples that she gives.
