Direct Object Pronouns

What are pronouns?

Pronouns **replace nouns** to make conversations and writings move more quickly.

1. One of the most commonly known French expressions, “Je t’aime” contains a direct object pronoun. The “te” (you) is the object of my verb “aime” (love). Watch this [video](#) as a reminder of all the pronouns and their placement in a sentence.
2. Pratiqons: Répondez aux questions avec un pronom.
 - a. Est-ce que tu aimes les fraises?
 - b. Tu manges les fruits de mer?
 - c. Est-ce que le Président regarde la télévision?
 - d. Mangez-vous le beurre?
