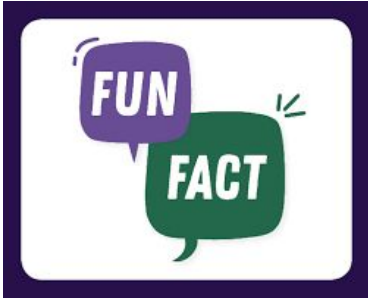

# Chez le médecin

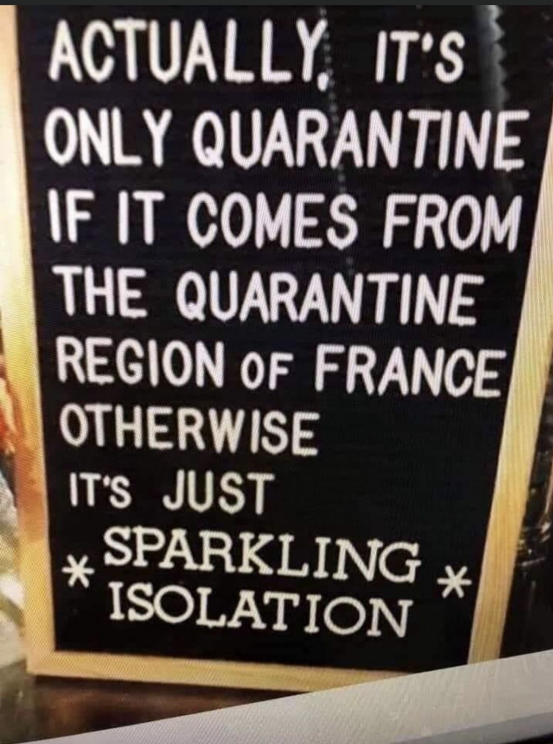
You are going to spend the next two days creating a dialog at the doctor's office. Refer to this [rubric](#) for all the details.
