**I can write simple German sentences about my classes.**



## Bellwork:

List your subjects out in German in the order you have them everyday.

Example:

1st: Mathe

2nd: Englisch

3rd: Deutsch

etc.



**A few words to have in your notes:**

**zuerst = first**

**dann = then**

**danach = after that**

**zuletzt = lastly**



**Let's see these in context.**

**Zuerst habe ich Mathe.**

**Dann habe ich Geschichte.**

**Danach habe ich Musik.**

**Zuletzt habe ich Deutsch.**

Here is my order of classes.

1: Mathe

2: Geschichte

3: Musik

4: Deutsch

The key to using **these words** is to make sure your verb is in the second position. Using the sentences from the last slide. Let's review our sentence parts. **Verb = red** **Subject = green**  
**Time = yellow** **Direct object = blue.**

**Zuerst** **habe** **ich** **Mathe.** → **First,** **I** **have** **math**

**Dann** **habe** **ich** **Geschichte.** → **Then,** **I** **have** **history.**

**Danach** **habe** **ich** **Musik.** → **After that,** **I** **have** **music.**

**Zuletzt** **habe** **ich** **Deutsch.** → **Lastly,** **I** **have** **German.**

Note:  
In German, you do NOT need a comma! Just remember that the **Verb** goes in position 2!
