**Objective/Learning Target:**

**I can say which classes I like and don't like.**

## Bellwork:

List out 4 subjects from yesterday and then describe them with an adjective.

Let's review: How to say I like to do something.

Ich spiele **gern** Tennis. → I play tennis **gladly**



Ich spiele **gern** Basketball → I play Basketball **gladly**



When doing something “gern”, this translates to liking to do an activity.

Ich mache **gern** Hausaufgabe → I **like** to do homework.

Let's review: How to say I do NOT like doing something.

Ich spiele **nicht gern** Tennis. → I play tennis **not gladly**.



Ich spiele **nicht gern** Basketball → I play Basketball **not gladly**.



When doing something “nicht gern”, this translates to NOT liking to do an activity.

Ich mache **nicht gern** Hausaufgabe → I **do not like** to do homework.

Putting that together with our school subjects.

We are going to use the verb: haben -- to have

This verb is “irregular” so use the chart to help.

ich habe
du hast
er/sie/es hat
wir haben
ihr habt
sie (many) / Sie (formal) haben

Putting that together with our school subjects.

Let's use this verb in context with a subject.

I have math. → Ich habe Mathe.

I have music. → Ich habe Musik.

I have history. → Ich habe Geschichte.

ich habe
du hast
er/sie/es hat
wir haben
ihr habt
sie (many) / Sie (formal) haben

Putting it ALL together.

Let's say now I like a subject. Notice the order-- the verb haben (**yellow**) comes second in the German sentence examples. Gern in green goes after the verb. Haben followed by gern means to like.

I **like** math. → Ich **habe** **gern** Mathe.

I **like** music. → Ich **habe** **gern** Musik.

I **like** history. → Ich **habe** **gern** Geschichte.



Now let's say I dislike a class.

Ich habe **gern** Mathe. → Ich habe **nicht gern** Mathe.

Ich habe **gern** Musik. → Ich habe **nicht gern** Musik.

Ich habe **gern** Geschichte. → Ich habe **nicht gern** Geschicht.

Note: Don't forget that the "nicht" comes right before the "gern".
