*the word "Sport" in German doesn't mean the same as Sports in English.

Each one of those activities on the previous page have a verb. You can conjugate this verb to talk about someone doing an activity. Before we look at some examples, review a conjugation chart first.

Let's look at some examples from our activity list and write a short sentence. To do this, you must first **conjugate** the verb.

Hint: the verb isn't capitalized and normally ends in "en". For these examples, I will use "ich". This takes an "e" ending.

lesen → Ich lese. → I read.

Musik hören → Ich höre Musik. → I listen to music.

ins Kino gehen → Ich gehe ins Kino. → I go to the movies.
