Objective/Learning Target:

I can identify the genitive case in German.



Bellwork: Write a sentence with the following prompt.

Write a sentence using the genitive case telling me about a relative's car.

Example: My dad's car is green.



You're more familiar with the Genitive case in English. What does it look like in German?

It's quite similar! Let's look at some examples!

Der Vaters^s Sohn. (The father's son).

Die Mutter^s Freund. (The mother's Friend).

You can add an "s" to a person to show ownership.
See? Quite similar!



Let's try that again. Try to see if you can find the Genitive!

Patricks Freundin heißt Jennifer.

Jennifers Hund haßt Katzen.

Jennifers Hund heißt Dino.

Dinos Essen ist kalt.

Fleisch ist Dino's Lieblingsessen

How did you do? Here is the genitive in German and English.

Patrick's Freundin heißt Jennifer.

(Patrick's girlfriend is called Jennifer)

Jennifer's Hund haßt Katzen.

(Jennifer's dog hates cats.)

Jennifer's Hund heißt Dino.

(Jennifer's dog is called Dino.)

Dino's Essen ist kalt.

(Dino's food is cold.)

Fleisch ist Dino's Lieblingsessen

(Meat is Dino's favorite food.)
