A comprobar: Formal and nosotros commands (1)

- Commands, or mandatos in Spanish, are used when we wish to tell someone what to do.
- The subject is never used with commands.
- Formal commands are used if the subject would be usted or ustedes.

A comprobar: Formal and *nosotros* commands (2)

- Formal commands are formed by:
 - Taking the yo form of a verb in the present: hablo, hago, sirvo
 - Removing the o: habl-, hag-, sirv-
 - Adding the opposite usted or ustedes endings:

 hable / hablen
 haga / hagan
 sirva / sirvan

A comprobar: Formal and *nosotros* commands (3)

Note the following irregularities:

 Some verbs change spelling in the command form to maintain pronunciation.

Verbs ending in:	Change to:	Examples
-car	que(n)	busque / busquen
–gar	gue(n)	pague / paguen
–ger	ja(n)	escoja / escojan
–zar	ce(n)	almuerce / almuercen

A comprobar: Formal and *nosotros* commands (4)

• The following have irregular formal command forms:

dar	dé (den)
estar	esté(n)
ir	vaya(n)
saber	sepa(n)
ser	sea(n)
