Mi mamá	me	regaló	el carro	a mí

The DO (DOP) pronouns are as follows: me, te, lo/la, nos, os, los/las.

The IO (IDOPS) pronouns are: me, te, le, nos, os, les.

But the pronouns change when we use both in the same sentence. **Example:**

IO	To whom?	DO	
Valerie le	compró a Julian	la camiseta	del Barcelona

In Spanish I **can not** do this combinations le lo, le la, les los, les las, le lo, le las **Get it**

Valerie **se** la compró. I changed the **le** for **se**.
