Hay diferentes distinciones o traducciones para usar la palabra "por" en una oración.

- "By" (authorship)
 - *The means by which something is created*
- "By" (close to)
 - *Can replace "cerca de"*
- "By" (transportation)
 - *The means by which something is done*

Por

- “Through”
- “In favor of”
- “On behalf of”
 - *Think of someone accepting an Oscar for someone who couldn't be there.*
- “In search of”
 - *Used after the verb ir.*
 - *Think of someone saying “Go for a doctor!”*
- “Per”
- Period of Time
- Motive
- Exchange/Price
- Math/Dimensions
