Para

Hay diferentes distinciones o traducciones para usar la palabra "para" en una oración.

- "In order to"
 - *This is probably the most common use of para*
 - *It will always be followed by an infinitive verb*
- "About to"
 - *Normally follows the verb estar*

Para

- Point of view
- Destination
 - *Normally after the verbs ir or salir*
 - *We might say "i'm headed for..."*
- Comparison to a Group
 - *This is probably the hardest use of para*
 - *It's normally based on a stereotype*
- Purpose of an Object/Action
- Recipient of a Gift
 - *On gift tags, it would say para for "to."*
- Due Dates
 - *For a future point in time*
