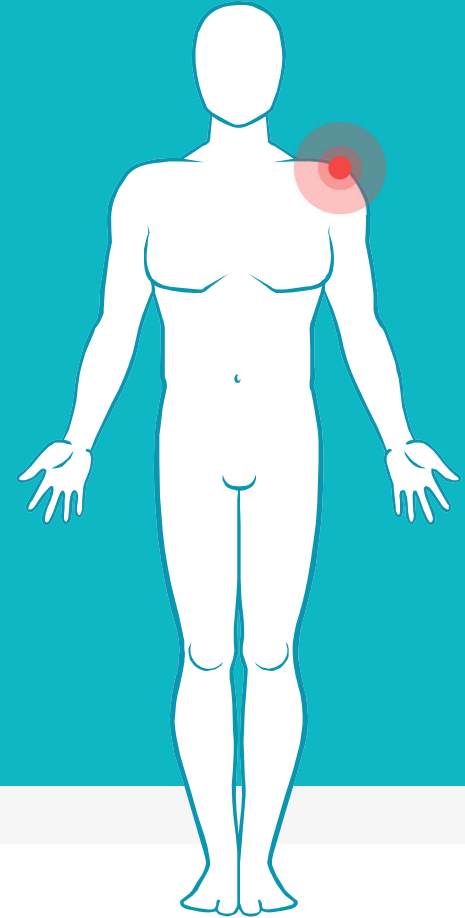


Principles of Infection Control
