### Key Terms Review

(Definitions from Lexico.com)

- **Foreign Service:** The government department concerned with the representation of a country abroad.
- **Diplomacy:** The profession, activity, or skill of managing international relations, typically by a country's representatives abroad.
- **Diplomat:** An official representing a country abroad.
- Ambassador: An accredited diplomat sent by a country as its official representative to a foreign country.

- "The mission of a U.S. diplomat in the Foreign Service is to promote peace, support prosperity, and protect American citizens while advancing the interests of the U.S. abroad." - U.S. Department of State website



#### Activity

Using information from the U.S. Department of State (DOS) website, you're going to design a one-page "Want Ad" for <u>both</u> a <u>Foreign Service Officer</u> and a <u>Foreign</u> <u>Service Specialist</u>. Make sure to include the following elements on the ad:

- 1. Job description What do they do?
- 2. Educational requirements What schooling is required for the job?
- 3. Non-educational requirements Other than schooling, what are some things they should like/be able to do?
- 4. Salary How much do they make? (this one will likely require more digging on the DOS website)

You can do this on Google Docs, Microsoft Word, or use a web-based program like Canva. Remember, this is a "want ad" so you're going to want to build it up to get the best people to join. Make it look good and make it right! (Example from another career field on next slide.)
