Objective: Students will calculate the total cost of purchasing a set of machinist tools and how to budget of them.

How many tools do you have at home that you could take with you to work at a machine shop?

Introduction

In order to work in a machine shop setting, you must have your own measuring tools and hand tools. There are a core set of tools that will work for any shop that you work for and then there are specific tools that are unique for that company. Most companies will give you 90 days to have these core tools purchased.

Introduction Continued

In this lesson you will be given a core set of tools that you will need to find the price of. There are 3 top brands that most shops will want you to purchase for precision measuring tools. The top brands are Starrett, Mitutoyo and Brown & Sharp. It does not matter what brand you purchase for the other hand tools.

Introduction Continued

There have be 2 vendors provided that sell these tools. You will need to look up the price for each tool made by each brand. Create a spread sheet to keep track of the price of each tool along with the price from the 2 vendors provided. You will also need to come up with a 3rd vendor on your own. Some of the tools have a brand listed

Introduction Continued

After you have found the price for each tool from each vendor, you will then need to know which tool will be purchased from which vendor. Create a new spread sheet for each vendor with a list of the tools and their price. Create a total for those vendors. The shipping cost will need to be added to each vendor if there is one.
