### **Objective/Learning Target:**

Students will learn about the architectural design process



## **Bell Ringer:**

### In 3 minutes, brainstorm as many different tasks that you can think of that would be involved in the design and construction of an architectural structure.



## **Bell Ringer:**

The tasks that you listed might have included things like finding out what the client needs or wants in their building, what style of architecture the client enjoys, what is the intended use of the building, or how much does the client want to spend? These are things that would be included in the programming phase of the project. Then there is conceptual design followed by construction documents and then calculating construction costs and the bidding phase. The last phase would be the actual construction of the project. Typically, the architect would manage the construction to make sure that the building will be what the architect designed and what the client is expecting.



# Let's get started:

There are many different iterations of the design process but most use the same basic steps. They may call them by different names or group tasks differently, but they all accomplish the same thing. Those basic steps are:

- Programming
- Conceptual Design
- Construction Documents
- Bidding/Costing
- Construction Administration
