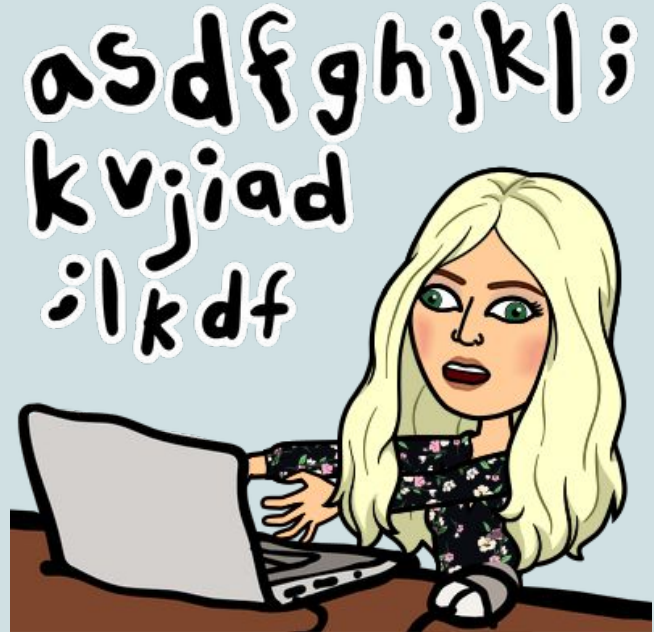

SHOW CHOIR

- Show choirs are groups who do mostly pop music and add choreography and costumes.
- Singing and dance are two big aspects of this type of choir
- Their shows usually have a story or theme that it follows
- Some schools or groups compete or others just do it for fun or it is a small part of their music program
 - The TV show, Glee, is about a show choir.



SHOW CHOIR

- Elements of show choir:
 - Solos
 - Ensemble singing
 - Dance
 - Set
 - Costumes
 - Band (live or not)
 - Props
