Objective/Learning Target: Students will be able to learn and play new scales- Eb, A, Em and Ab Major.



- Review scales: C, G, F, D, and Bb




NEW SCALE- KEY OF ЕЬ MAJOR

 - Eb F G Ab Bb C D Eb
 - Find the whole and half steps
 - WWHWWH
- Play through the scale a couple times



- The key of A Major has three sharps... F#, C#, G#
- The scale is:
 - \circ A B C# D E F# G# A
 - Find the whole and half steps
 - WWHWWH

A major scale




NEW SCALE: E MAJOR



- The key of E Major has four sharps... F#, C#, G#, D#
- The scale is:
 - E F# G# A B C# D# E
 - Find the whole and half steps
 - W W H W W H



NEW SCALE: Ab MAJOR


- The key of Ab Major has four flats... Bb, Eb, Ab, Db
- The scale is:
 - Ab, Bb, C, Db, Eb, F,
 G, Ab
 - Find the whole and half steps
 - W W H W W H
- Play through the scale a couple times

A-flat major scale


