## **Application Checklist**

#### Ready to apply for college? Here's what you need!

#### **Completed Application**

- Apply online for faster results.
- Double check to see if the college requires you to turn in any additional information (resume, essay, recommendation forms, etc).

#### Transcript Requests

- Each college needs an official copy of your transcript to consider you for admission. In order for us to send you transcript, you must first fill out the **Record Release Form.** If you are under 18, a parent/guardian must also sign the form. On the line that says consent to release to the following organizations put "ALL"
- Fill out your name on the Transcript Clip Board in Ms. Meyer's room so we know where to send your transcripts.

#### Application Fee

- If you receive free or reduced lunch, you are eligible for an **Application Fee Waiver**. Ask Ms. Meyer for more information.
- If you do *not* receive free or reduced lunch, you must pay the application fee. Some schools will let you apply for free online.

#### ACT Scores

• When you register to take the ACT- you can send your scores to 4 schools for free. ACT scores will also appear on your transcript, but some schools (ex: MU) will only accept the score sent from ACT. Make sure to add schools to your ACT registration.

### Scholarship Application

• Make sure to submit any additional forms needed to qualify for institutional scholarships. Applying for outside scholarships should be an on-going process all year.

# After applying, make sure to check your mail and email REGULARLY! This is how schools will inform you of acceptance, additional material they may need from you, and scholarship applications.
