Study Spelling Words: Choose at least two.

Guardian Initials

- Complete a practice spelling test and copy missed words 3 times each.
- Write all words in crayon. Trace over them with two different colors.
- Practice spelling each word aloud with an adult. Copy missed words 3 times each.
- Write all words in alphabetical order (a-z) and then backward alphabetical order (z-a).
- Write a story, poem, or paragraph correctly using all spelling words.
- Type all words five times each on a computer or tablet.
- Write all words 2 times each choosing one color for vowels and another for consonants.

Guardian Initials

Practice Math Skills: Choose at least two.

- Choose four 1-digit numbers and write multiplication facts up to 12 for each.
(example: $4 \times 2 = 8$, $4 \times 3 = 12$, $4 \times 4 = 16$, $4 \times 5 = 20$, etc.)
- Practice mult. or division flashcards with someone at home for 30 minutes.
(Flashcards can be purchased at Dollar Tree for \$1, or create your own.)
- Create and solve three 4-digit addition and three four-digit subtraction problems.
(examples: $1,532 + 1,329$; $2,472 - 1,215$)
- Create and solve five two-digit by two-digit multiplication problems.
(example: 42×17) Check with a calculator.
- Create and solve four three-digit by one-digit division problems. (example: $423 \div 9$)
