Background: Students use sounds, sight words, and pictures to write on a prompt/topic


- Students will use dictation to respond to a prompt

Practice #1:


Warm up by writing your first and last name using capitalization and <u>formation</u>



Ask a grown up to write a model for you if you can't remember all the letters.


Practice #2: Write the Room

Did you remember?


A sentence needs:

Check your sentence now. If you need to, fix your sentence.


