Background:

1. <u>Daily sound review</u>


Practice #1, 2, & 3:

- 3. Using some of the words you wrote you will write a sentence to go with the picture.

Practice reading the sentence you wrote.

Make any changes you need to so that it is perfect!

Check that you have:

- A capital at the beginning
- ☐ Spaces between your words
- Punctuation at the end
