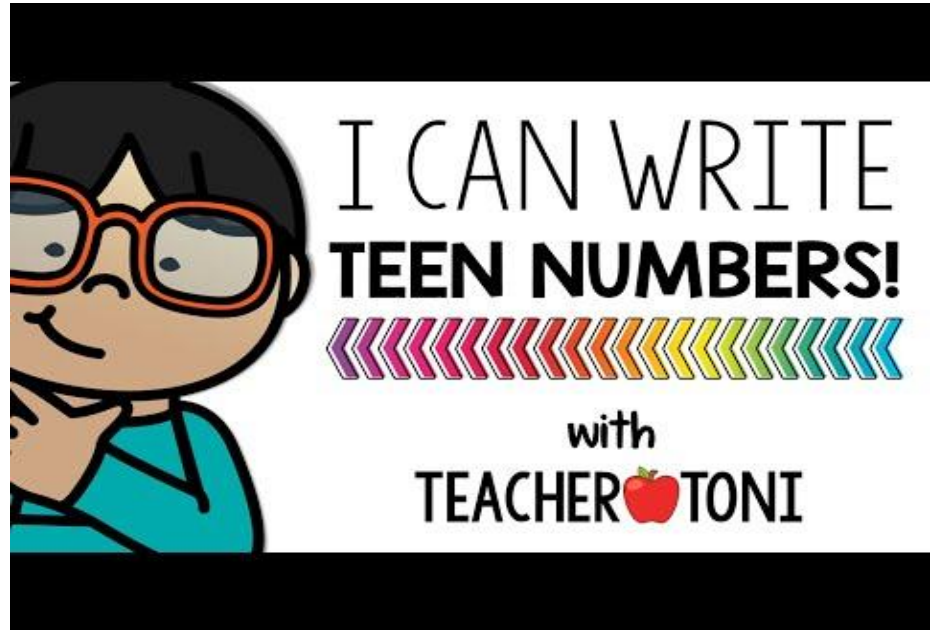

Show me another way you could see these objects.

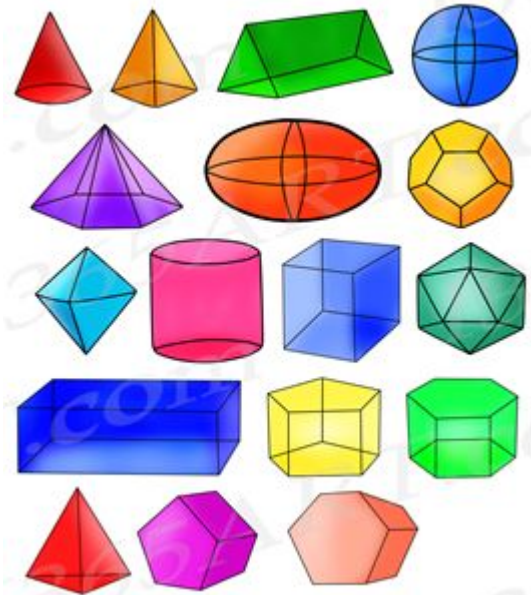
You could have seen 8

Let's Check

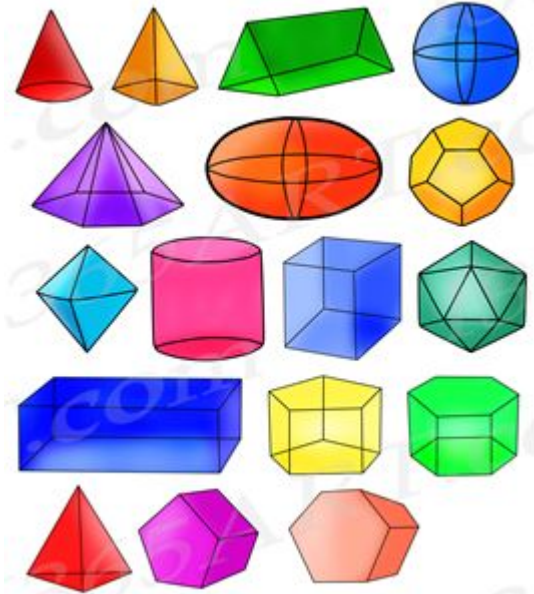
How many did you count?

17.

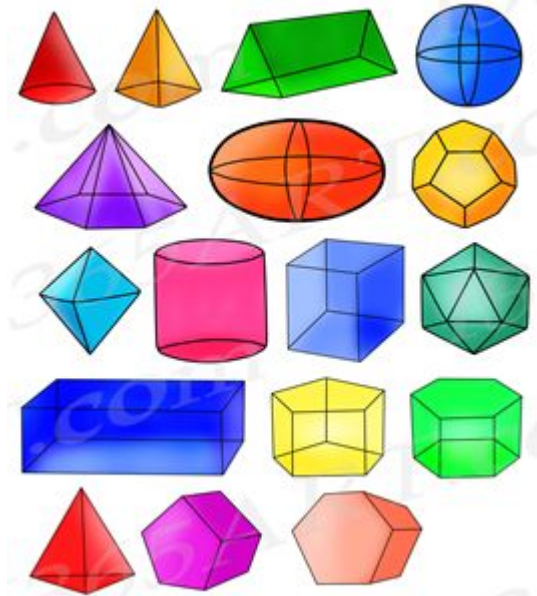
Way to go you did great!

Explain how you saw them.



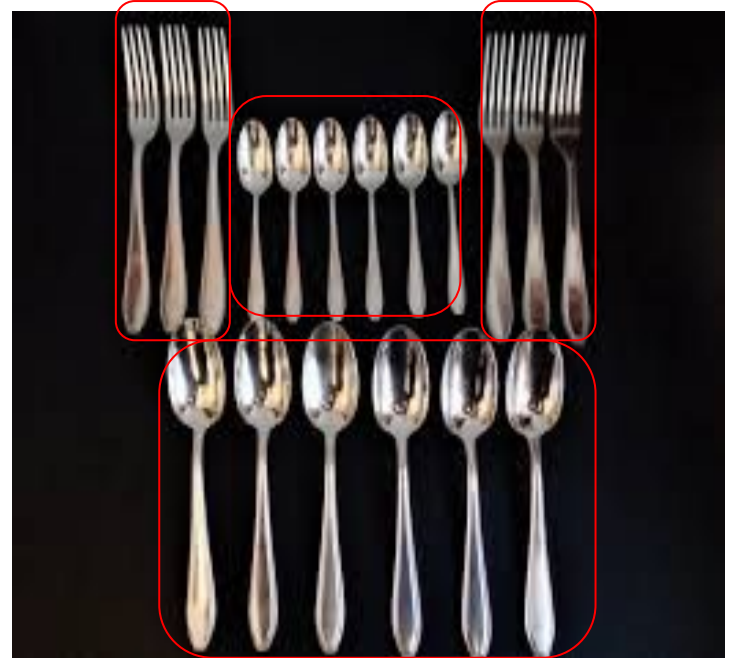
*Practice #2:

How Many Did You See It?

I saw 3 forks and 3 more forks which makes 6.
Then I saw 6 spoons and 6 more spoons. That makes 12. 6 and 12 makes 18.

1. Write your numbers from 0-20 on a sheet of paper.









