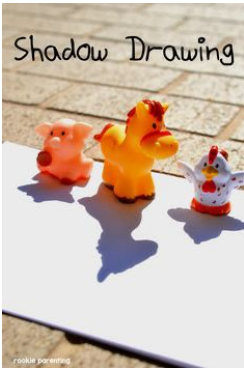

Lesson: April 13, 2020

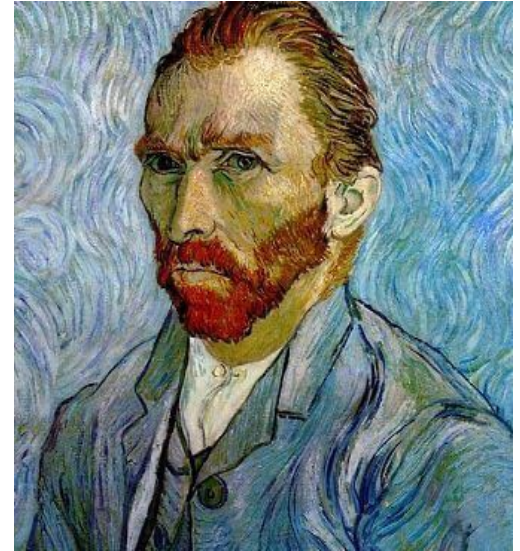
Learning Target:

Students will create artwork that communicates ideas about indoors.

Background: This is a review lesson from earlier in the school year

- Students learn to produce a line using crayon, pencil or marker.
- Students learn to identify and use shapes.
- Students learn to identify and use color.

Van Gogh was a Post-Impressionist artist who painted sunflower still lifes during the mid-late 1800's.

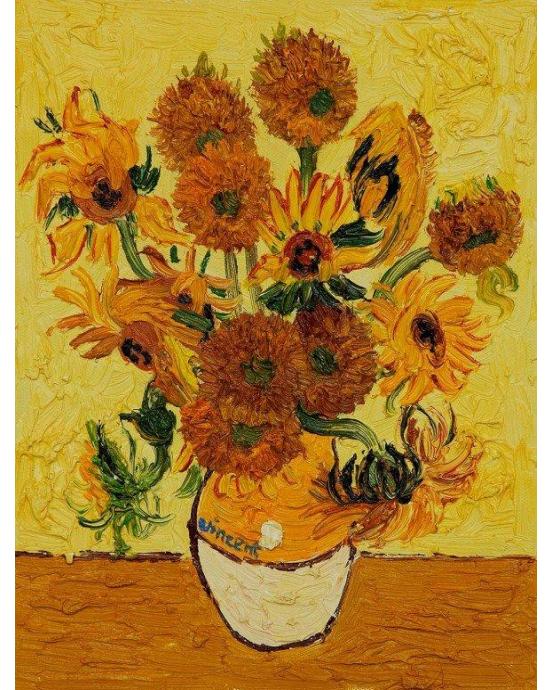

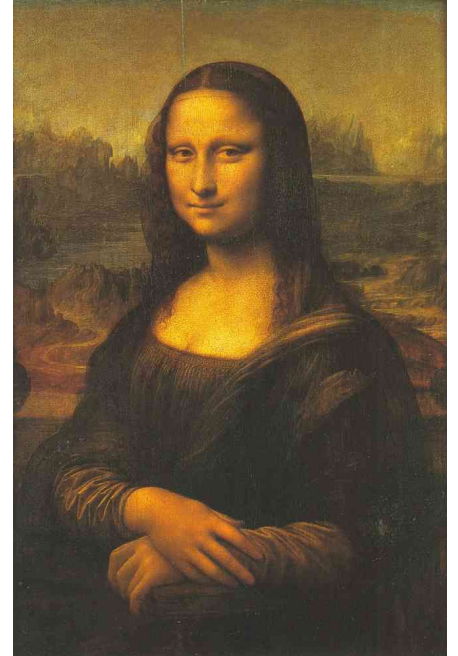

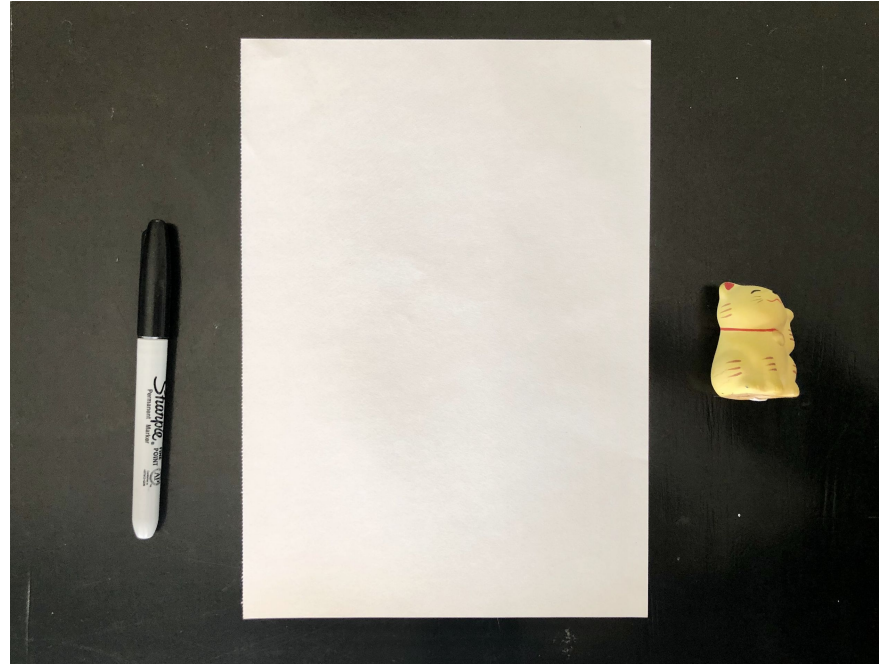

Practice on your own: creating shadow still lifes



Practice on your own: creating shadow still lifes

Step 1: Gather materials. You need a piece of paper, something to write with and a small object from your house. Make sure you ask an adult if you can use it first!



Practice on your own: creating shadow still lifes

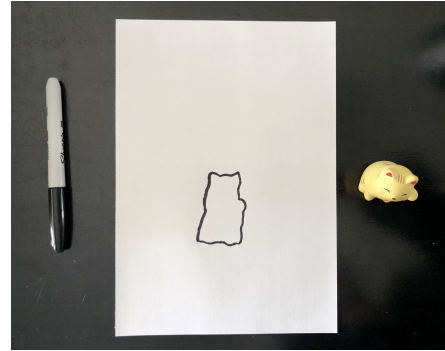
Step 2: Ask an adult if you can go outside. Find a sunny spot where there's a flat area to draw. Place your object on the paper and trace it.



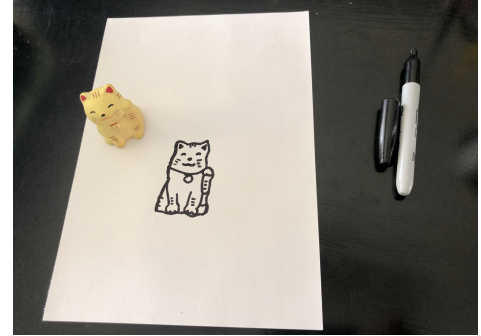
Practice on your own: creating shadow still lifes

Step 3: Go back inside, and draw the inside detail you see on the object and give it a background with at least 3 details. Think of things in your house you could draw around it.

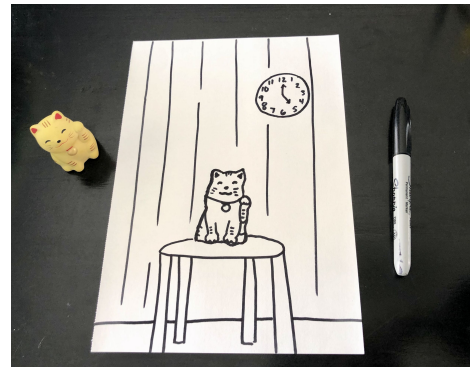

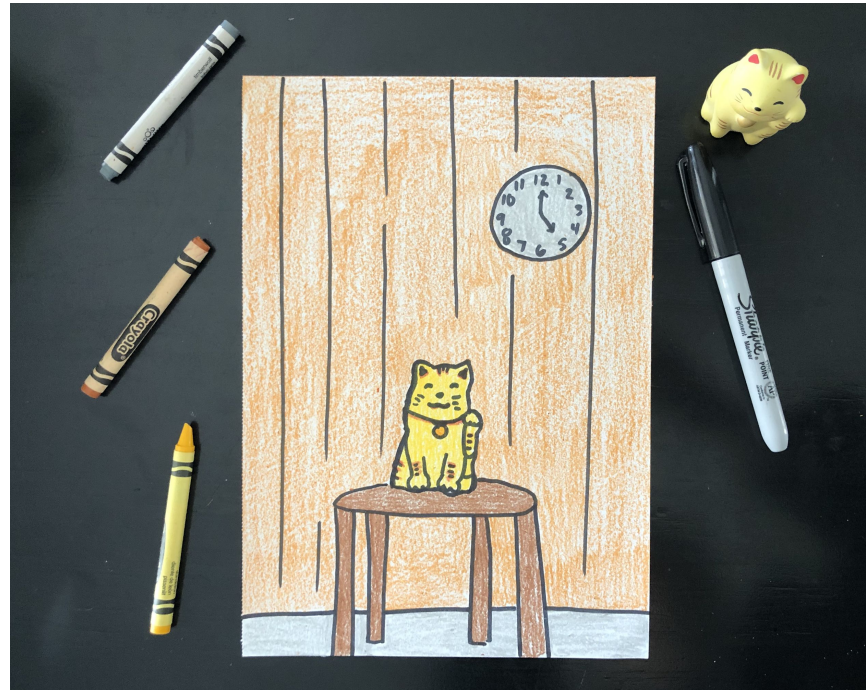
