




ECSE/Program Social Emotional Learning

Learning Target: Students will learn about using good manners.

Using good manners means being polite to everyone!

Can you remember some of the words used in the book to show good manners?



Now, let's choose one of the good manners to work on, and practice this with a grown-up today!

(Instructions for Adults) Materials:

- Toys around the house


Directions:

- 1) Engage in pretend play with your child.
- 2) Adult will demonstrate one of the good manners chosen by the child
- 3) The child will practice using the good manners chosen
- 4) Adult will praise child for using good manners



Here's an example to teach "please" and "thank you".

Step	What you do	Then say
1	Pretend that you want a toy (e.g., ball) that is out of reach	Pass the ball, please
2	When your child gives you the ball	Thank you for passing the ball
3	Place toys that your child is playing with out of his/her reach	You can say "ball, please"
4	Praise your child for using good manners	Good job saying please and thank you
