Warm Up:





In the summer we can <u>swim</u> in a <u>pool</u>.




We can wear a <u>bathing suit</u>.

Camping is for <u>roasting</u> <u>marshmallows</u> on the fire.






You might even get to make <u>s'mores</u>!
