










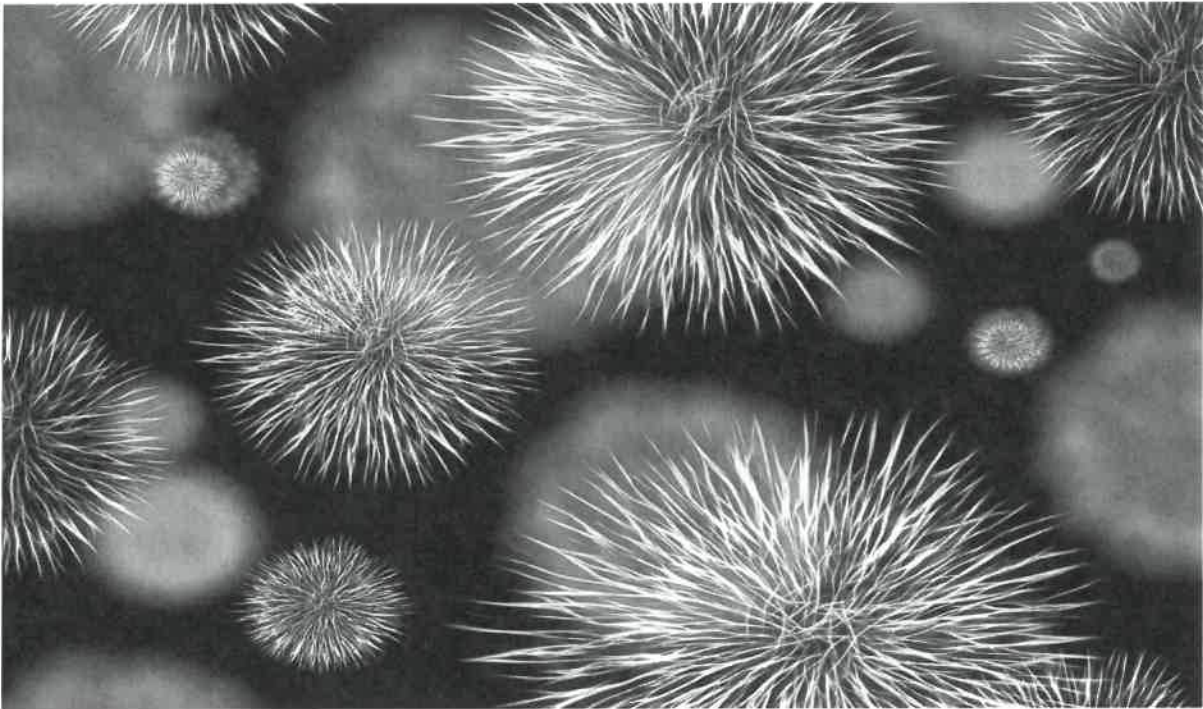

COVID-19



Some people are getting sick with the coronavirus / COVID-19 .

Stopping Germs

When we can't wash our hands, we can use hand sanitizer.

Also, try not to touch your face.

I will go back to school when the COVID-19 germs are gone!

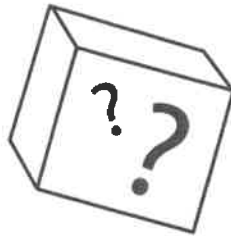
