










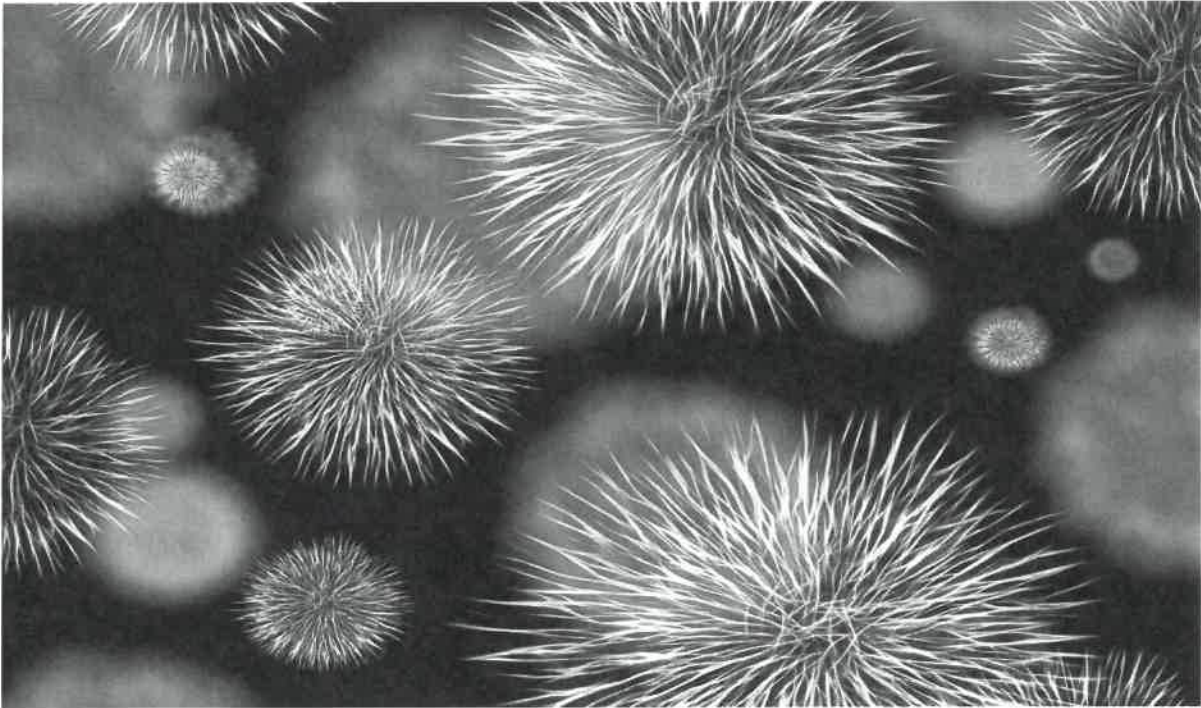

Older people, not kids, have been getting sick from COVID-19.

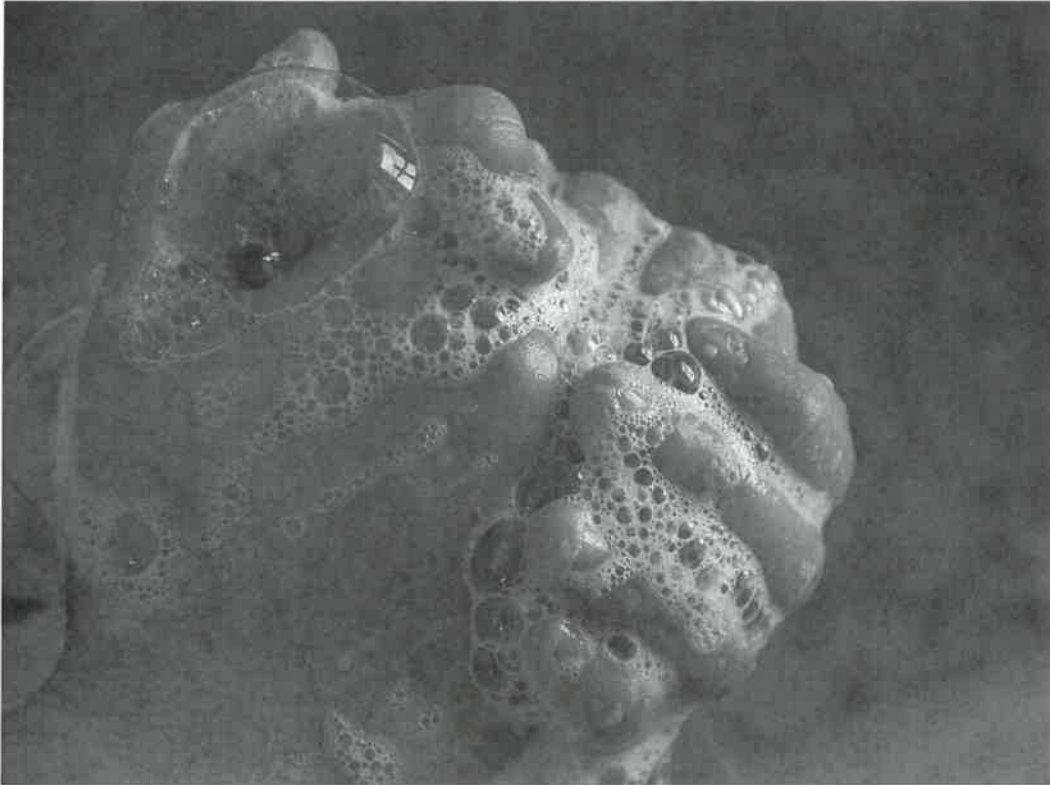
Sick people can be tested to check if it is COVID-19.
