Kindergarten Writing Lesson: April 13

Learning Target:

- Students will use words to respond to a prompt

- 2. Review <u>sight words</u>
- 3. Watch Video: The Sentence Song

I can write my name!




Ask a grown up to write a model for you if you can't remember all the letters.

Write the Room


Draw and label 3 things you see in your living room.


