## Practice #1:

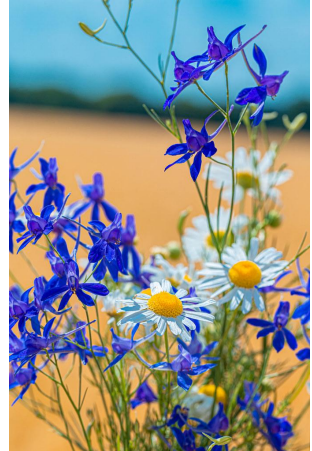
Read this short paragraph and answer question.

## Practice #2:

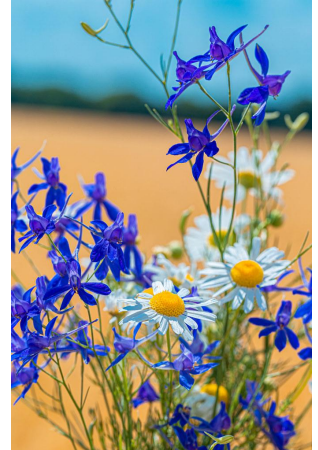
Read this short paragraph and answer question.

Question: What couldn't she find?

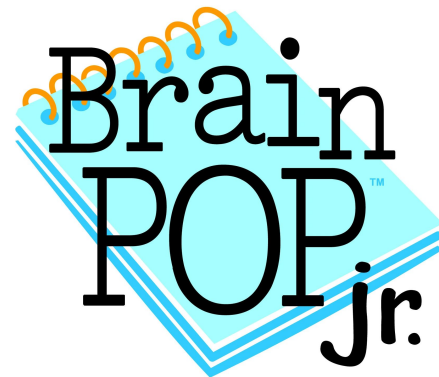
Question: What is a fistful of flowers called?
